

English I preAP

If you want to register for English I preAP, please consider the following:

- Your present English teacher is a good source to analyze your ability. Talk to him/her about whether or not you should take English I preAP.
- AP and preAP class teachers expect you to think independently and on a higher analytical level.
- To be successful, you must be willing to do all your homework, take notes in class, and participate in class discussions. AP and preAP classes are not “spectator classes.”
- Students in AP and PAP classes enjoy reading. If reading is not one of your favorite subjects, this may not be for you!
- If you expect an AP or preAP class to raise your GPA, consider this:

grade from regular classes	equivalent grade from AP/preAP
98	90
95	87
93	85
90	82

From experience, a student's grades may drop as much as 10 points or more when going from a regular to a preAP or AP class.
