

Family and Consumer Sciences

Interior Design- This $\frac{1}{2}$ credit course offered to 10th- 12th grades covers concepts and skills to successfully decorate a home and/or business while addressing period styles, surface treatments, lighting, use of design, space planning, and color. Some supply fees may be required.



Apparel- This $\frac{1}{2}$ credit course offered to 10th-12th grades focuses on individual fashion decisions, the apparel industry, and related careers as well as clothing construction.



Personal and Family Development- This 1 credit course offered to 9th-12th grades is a comprehensive class in which students will acquire knowledge in the areas of family living, child development, clothing, housing management, nutrition, personal and family health, and the relationship between the home and the work place. A small lab fee is required.



Child Development- 10th-12th grade students may take this $\frac{1}{2}$ credit course in which knowledge and skills will be gained in the areas of child development, care and protection. Emphasis will be placed on the physical, emotional, social, and intellectual development and well-being of children.



Ready, Set, Teach! I and II- This field-based course is offered to 11th - 12th grade students and provides a background knowledge of child and adolescent development principles as well as principles of effective teaching practices. Students work under the joint direction and supervision of both a family and consumer sciences teacher and an exemplary educator in direct instruction roles with elementary, middle, and/or high school-aged students in Lewisville ISD schools. Students are involved in observations as well as direct student instruction. Students must provide their own transportation to field site schools.



Nutrition and Food Science- This laboratory class for 10th-12th grades addresses nutrition, food choices, and food management with instructional emphasis placed on food habits and wellness, menu planning, food costs and budgeting, food safety and sanitation and related careers. A lab fee is required.

Food Science and Technology- This class is offered to grades 10th-12th. This laboratory course addresses food science principles, special dietary needs, nutrition and wellness, diet related disorders, food safety and sanitation, world food supply, and careers related to nutrition, food science, and technology. Nutrition and Food Science is a required prerequisite. A lab fee is required.



Individual and Family Life- This class is for 10th-12th grade students and provides opportunities for self-analysis and personal growth. The course addresses the responsibilities of living as an independent adult and gives assistance in planning for relationships and marriage.
