RECOMMENDED PROGRAM

- **English: I, II, III, IV (4 Credits)**
- **Math: Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II , one additional math (4 Credits)**
- **Science: Biological and Physical Sciences (4 Credits)**
One credit must be Biology and two credits will be from Chemistry, Physics, or IPC. For credit in IPC the course must be taken before the senior year. The fourth credit can be from any other science course offered
- **Social Studies: World Geography, World History, US History, U. S. Government, Economics (4 credits)**

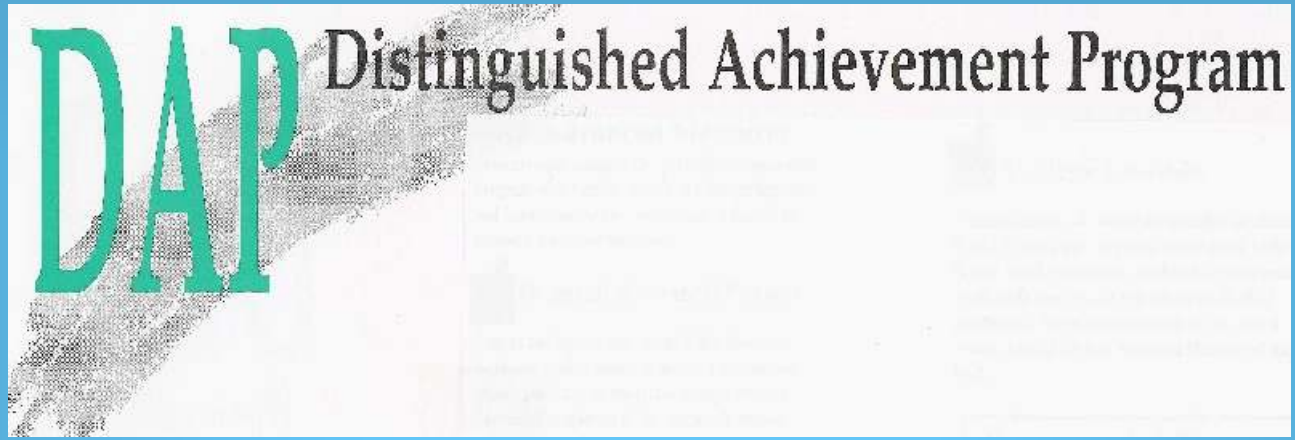

What do I have to do to get promoted in high school?

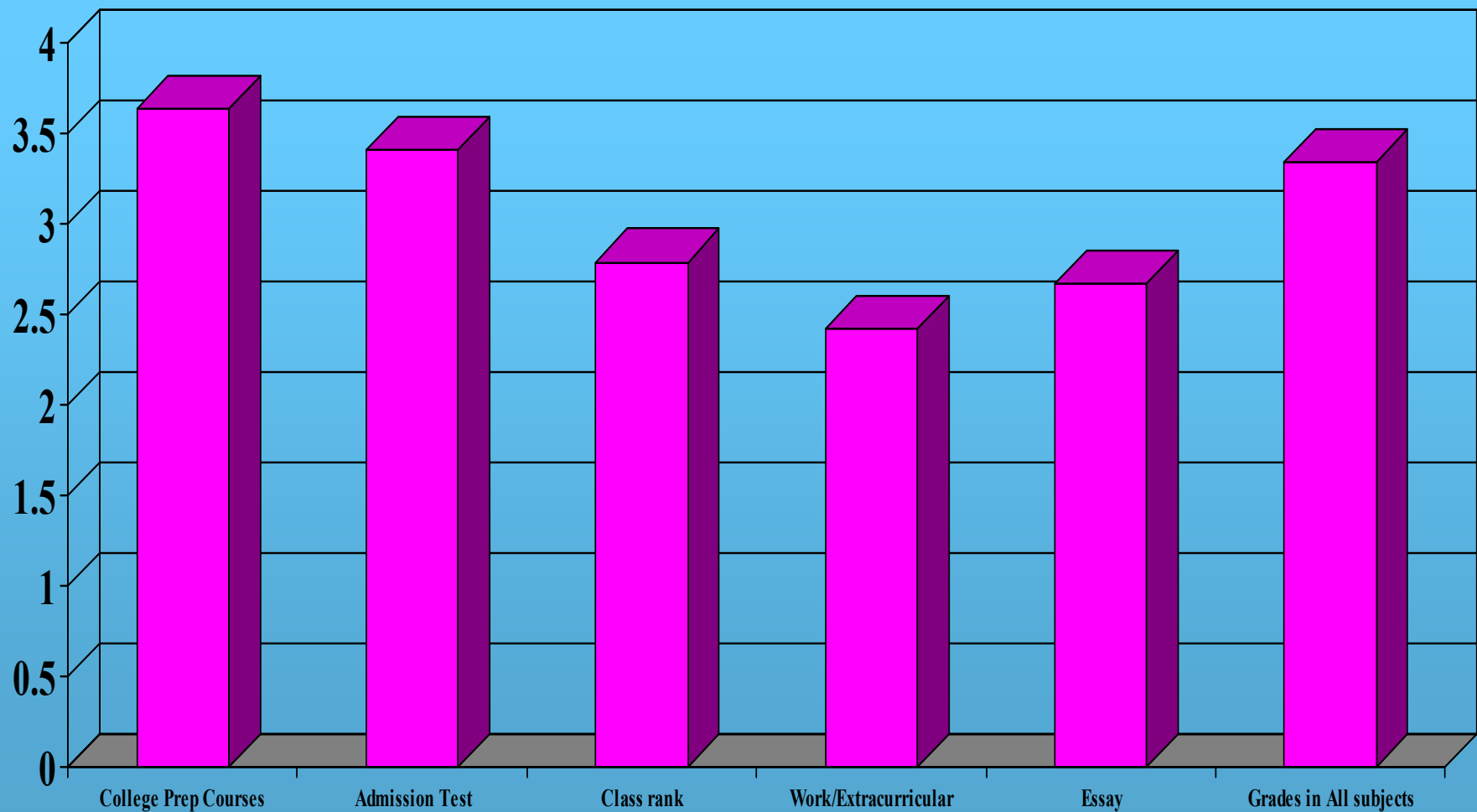

Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS)

- **9th grade students will take READING and MATH in April.**
- **10th grade students will take ELA in March and SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES, and MATH in April.**
- **The scores students make on TAKS in both 9th and 10th grade are very important: These scores are included on your transcript and will be sent to perspective colleges – not just the exit level test taken in 11th grade.**
- **Give your best effort when you prepare for the tests.
Work hard in each of your courses.
Attend tutorial sessions when they are offered.**
- **Give your best effort when you take the tests in the spring.**
