However, the Selective Service System now accepts early submission of registration by 17 year old men. **HELPFUL FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION**

Apply to the college or university of your choice by the application deadline. Complete the FAFSA form as soon after January 1 as possible. [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). It takes the federal government 6 weeks to process your request for financial aid and return your forms to the college of your choice. If you are denied aid from the federal government, you are then considered for institutional aid. Students cannot receive financial aid from their school without first completing FAFSA.

**Do you need help paying for college or for a career or vocational school?** This section is a quick reference to our federal student aid programs and how to apply. The rest of this publication provides more detail of what you need to know. Most student financial aid comes from the federal government programs you'll read about here, which the U.S. Department of Education's Federal Student Aid office administers. Applying for federal student aid is FREE; that's why our application is called the **Free Application for federal student Aid (FAFSA)**. If you need help completing the FAFSA, that help is free too. You don't have to pay anyone for assistance. Beware of scams and services that will search for financial aid money for you for a fee. The College Scholarship Fraud Protection Act protects you from this type of fraud.
