Prizes - Grades 6, 7 & 8:

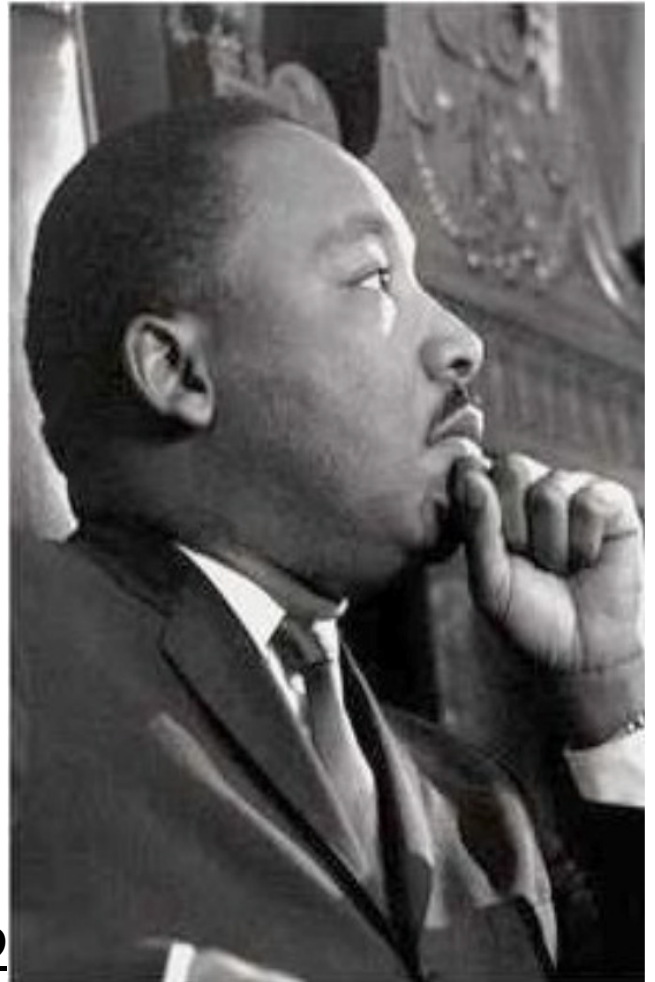
First - \$100; Second - \$75, Third - \$50
