About the PSAT Team:

- Sophomores who scored 160 or higher on the October 2007 PSAT were invited to participate on the Class of '10 PSAT Team. We have almost 140 students who have chosen to accept this invitation.
- The purpose of the PSAT Team is to maximize a student's potential to achieve National Merit recognition when they take the PSAT/NMSQT in October of their junior year.
- In our experience, PSAT Team members increase their PSAT an average of about 25 points, but we have seen students increase their PSAT score by as much as 50 points.
- Although the number of FMHS National Merit Scholars varies from year to year, our school record is 22 National Merit Semi-Finalist (Class of 2006).

PSAT Team Requirements:

- Attend **Parent/Student Meeting on March 13** @ 7 p.m. in the FMHS Auditorium.
- Attend the **PSAT Team Summer Session, August 4 - 8**, at FMHS.
- Take the **PSAT Team Class** in the 1st 9-weeks. This class counts as a local elective.
- Attend four **Saturday Practice Sessions** in late September and early October. Specific dates will be determined after College Board releases the PSAT/NMSQT Test date for October 2008. (There will be alternate mid-week sessions offered as well.)
